Perennials for Sunny Spots

Perennial plants that want more than 6 hours of sun a day All plants in this section are in 1-gallon pots unless noted otherwise.

Yarrow

Achillea 'Moonshine' \$14.00

For sunny, hot, dry sites, yarrow is a proven performer. Popular with butterflies and bees but not with deer, this yellow hybrid introduced in the 1950s features silvery foliage and gets almost 3' tall. Great as a cut or dried flower.

Yarrow

Achillea 'Terracotta' \$14.00

For sunny, hot, dry sites, yarrow is a proven performer. Popular with butterflies and bees but not with deer, the flowers of this hybrid emerge a bright peach color and turn to a clay pot color. Gets almost 3' tall.

Wormwood

Artemesia 'Silver Mound' \$14.00

A low mounding, silvery foliage plant that looks great on the edge of a garden path. Does not need a lot of watering and is deer resistant.









Swamp Milkweed

Ascelpias incarnata \$14.00

This native wetland perennial does well in moist soils and rain gardens. It is a host plant for Monarch butterfly caterpillars but attracts many other pollinators as well. It features a cluster of upturned deep pink flowers that bloom mid-summer.

Butterfly Weed

Asclepias tuberosa \$14.00

Bright orange flowers attract all sorts of butterflies and of course it is a host plant for Monarch butterflies. The plant itself grows about 24" tall and is a rugged performer in the summer garden. May be late coming out in the spring.

Whorled Milkweed

Asclepias verticillata \$14.00

An adaptable and tough native. Fine foliage makes a great backdrop for white flowers and serves as a caterpillar host. Blooms in summer.

Heath Aster

Aster eriocoides 'Snow Flurry' \$14.00

White flowers smother this carpet-like groundcover in early fall. A strong grower that grows only 6" tall but can spread 24" wide. Excellent in containers.

Calico Aster

Aster laterifolius 'Lady in Black' \$14.00

Tiny white daisies with dark eyes cover a 3–4' mound of dark leaves in the fall. An excellent plant for butterflies in the late summer and early fall.











Aster Aster novae-angliae 'Purple Dome' \$14.00

This tried-and-true aster is a great flower to have in the fall. This native cultivar is compact, growing only to 18" or so. Attracts butterflies and bees late into the season.

Aromatic Aster

Aster oblongifolius 'Raydon's Favorite' \$14.00

Medium blue flowers bloom in early fall. Aromatic foliage that grows to 3' tall. It does well in dry sunny spots and is deer resistant.

Aster

Aster 'Pink Crush' \$14.00

A stunning round mound of rose-pink flowers appears in late summer. It grows about 24" tall and 35" wide. Great for attracting late season butterflies and bees.

Tatarian Aster

Aster tataricus 'Jindai' \$14.00

This late season bloomer is great for pollinators in the fall. Clusters of small blue daisy-like flowers top a 4-5' tall stem, so this works well in the back of any flower bed.

False Indigo

Baptisia 'American Goldfinch' \$16.00

A big plant with bright color that will make a statement in any garden. This is a heavily flowering yellow cultivar of our native false indigo.

Baptisia australis 'Plum Rosy' \$16.00

Bicolor spikes bloom in May and are a great transition bloomer in mid to late spring. Growing 3–4' tall, this is a good plant for the middle or back of the flower bed and the leaves make a great back background for other plants.

Tickseed

Coreopsis 'Daybreak' \$14.00

Golden yellow flowers with orange-red centers top this easy growing plant. It stays a tidy 8–14" tall and needs little attention. Good for cut flowers.

Coreopsis 'Red Satin' \$14.00

A red selection of the threadleaf coreopsis that makes a great accent. A little more compact than the straight species, it will grow to about 18" tall and wide.

Montbretia

Crocosmia 'Lucifer' \$14.00

Tall sword-like leaves make this plant a spiky vertical element in garden design and the red blooms on wiry stems just add to that. It will get 36" tall, but only about 12" wide. The red tubular flowers are attractive

hummingbirds. It loves full sun but can tolerate some light shade.

Ice Plant

Delosperma 'Granita Raspberry' \$14.00

Bright blooms cover this ground cover that spreads 30" wide. Heat and drought tolerant with its succulent foliage. It does best in well drained soils, making it an excellent plant for containers, rock gardens and slopes.

















Pinks *Dianthus* 'Pinky Promise' \$14.00

This colorful but low growing plant (6-8" tall) is perfect for the front of a flower bed or along the edge of a walk. Fuchsia pink flowers make this a charmer.

Yellow Coneflower

Echinacea paradoxa \$14.00

A yellow purple coneflower is certainly the paradox. Bright drooping petals surround a brown cone that is popular with goldfinches. It will grow 2–3' tall it does well in limestone soils—perfect for the Shenandoah Valley.

Purple Coneflower

Echinacea purpurea 'Magnus' \$14.00

A North American native great for attracting insects and birds to your garden. Growing 36" tall, it is topped with large purple daisy-like flowers in late summer. Adaptable to most situations as long as it gets plenty of sun.

Purple Coneflower

Echinacea purpurea 'Mellow Yellows' \$14.00

The the flowers of this cultivar range from cream to bright yellow. It will get 24-30" tall.

Purple Coneflower

Echinacea 'Pow Wow White' \$14.00

This is a seed selection of the purple coneflower that produces pure white flowers with golden centers. Slightly more compact, it grows about 24" tall.











Joe-Pye Weed

Eupatorium dubium 'Little Joe' \$14.00

This compact cultivar of the native perennial (3–4' tall) features clusters of pink purplish flowers in late summer. It likes moist places and attracts a variety of pollinators including many butterflies. Excellent for back of the garden border.

Blanket Flower

Gaillardia aristata 'Arizona Sun' \$14.00

Masses of orange-red blooms cover this native cultivar each summer. Once established, little care and watering is needed, and it can be quite drought tolerant. Deer resistant and it attracts pollinators. Low mounding habit, growing to about 10" tall and wide.

Sneezeweed

Helenium autumnale \$14.00

This is a tall perennial (3–5' tall) features bright yellow daisy-like flowers. It does well in moist/wet locations but can tolerate drier locations once established. A perfect plant for rain gardens. It is a favorite for pollinators.

Willowleaf Sunflower

Helianthus salicifolius 'Autumn Gold' \$14.00

Narrow willow-like leaves form a compact mound that grows 24" high and wide. Yellow flowers bloom from September to frost. Good companion for asters and mums in the fall. Drought tolerant and good for pollinators.

False Sunflower

Heliopsis helianthoides 'Sunstruck' \$14.00

Large golden flowers last from summer through to fall. This is compact form, staying about 15" tall and 13" wide fits in well in a garden flower bed. Also good in containers.













Daylily Hemerocallis 'Jolyene Nichole' \$14.00

Ruffled petals with rose veining draws your eye to the vellow eve of this rugged daylily. Does well in poor and/or dry soils.

Hibiscus

Hibiscus 'Airbrush Effect' \$16.00

This plant features large, 8" wide pink flowers with a dark eye. While it projects a tropical vibe, this is a cultivar of a plant that is native from Canada to Florida and is hardy in the Winchester area. The plant gets big (4' tall and 4' wide) so make sure to give it some room in your garden.

Hibiscus

Hibiscus 'Watermelon Ruffles' \$16.00

This plant features large, 7" wide magenta flowers with ruffled edges. Hardy in the Winchester area. The plant gets wide (4' tall and 4' wide) so make sure to give it some room in your garden.

Blue Flag Iris

Iris versicolor \$14.00

A robust native iris that does well in moist or wet areas. Violet-blue flowers spread wide over sword-like leaves. Grows 2-3' tall.

Japanese Aster

Kalimeris incisa 'Blue Star' \$14.00

This mounding plant (18" tall and 24" wide) features masses of small lavender daisy flowers from June until autumn. Loves heat and humidity and tolerates drought. Similar to other Asters and Boltonia.

Red Hot Poker

Kniphofia 'Lady Luck' \$14.00

A great plant for sunny spots without much water. Tall spikes of white and yellow tubes draw all sorts of pollinators and hummingbirds, yet the deer don't like this plant. Flowers can reach 40" tall.

Shasta Daisy

Leucanthemum superbum 'Becky' \$14.00

A sturdy cultivar, this daisy produces loads of white flowers each summer. It stands tall at 36" but does not require staking to keep it up. Removing spent blooms helps keep the flowers going during the summer.

Dwarf Blazing Star

Liatris spicata 'Kobold' \$14.00

This prairie native is a smaller, compact form of the regular species. When the spikes are blooming in early to midsummer, expect to find them covered in butterflies. The purple spikes will stand 18–20" tall. Deer resistant.

Maltese Cross

Lychnis arkwrightii 'Orange Gnome' \$14.00

It's hard to miss this colorful plant in the garden, with brilliant orange flowers on purplish-green leaves. It blooms in early summer and the flowers can last for weeks. It tolerates a variety of soils as long as it gets plenty of sun.

Muhly Grass

Muhlenbergia capillaris' \$14.00

One of the most ornamental native grasses, it forms a nice 30" tall clump of wiry grass for much of the summer but explodes with pink airy flowers in late summer, early fall. Takes full sup and drought conditions. This cultivar is more

Catmint

Nepeta x faassenii 'Walker's Low' \$14.00

Aromatic leaves and soft blue flowers make this a great plant to place along the edge of a path. Blooms through the summer and attracts all sorts of pollinators. Grows to about 24" tall. Does not need much water and is deer resistant.

Beardtongue

Penstemon 'Prairie Dusk' \$14.00

Beardtongue is a solid performer in the garden with dramatic spikes of colorful flowers. This cultivar features rose-purple flowers. It is not bothered by heat and humidity and is quite drought tolerant.

Russian Sage

Perovskia atriplicfolia 'Blue Jean Baby' \$14.00

This perennial loves hot dry locations and is a rugged plant for the garden. It features airy spikes of flowers on silvery foliage and makes an effective filler in the garden. Smaller than other Russian Sages, this cultivar grows 2-3' tall and 30" wide.

Woodland Phlox

Phlox divaricata 'Blue Moon' \$14.00

This spring flowering phlox has bright fragrant lavender flowers in April/May. Staying compact, it will only grow 12–18" tall with glossy foliage staying about 6" tall. Foliage sprawls and plays well with other plants. Attracts butterflies and even hummingbirds.

Tall Garden Phlox

Phlox paniculata 'Jeana' \$14.00

This cultivar is very mildew resistant and is covered in lavender-pink flowers in the summer. A pollinator magnet. It is a tall plant, growing 4–5' tall.













Tall Garden Phlox

Phlox paniculata 'Material Girl' \$14.00

Another mildew resistant phlox, this plant features fuchsia purple flowers on sturdy stems. Great for pollinators. Grows to 38" inches tall and wide.

Creeping Phlox

Phlox Violet Pinwheels' \$14.00

A mat-forming phlox with bright starlike flowers. An excellent ground cover staying about 5" tall and provides bright blue-purple flowers for early season pollinators.

Creeping Phlox

Phlox subulata 'Drummond's Pink' \$14.00

A long-flowering rose-pink creeping phlox, this is a great plant for steep slopes, retaining walls and rock gardens. It will spread out to form a small carpet only 6" tall. Drought tolerant.

Obedient Plant

Physostegia virginiana 'Pink Manners' \$14.00

This clumping cultivar does not spread aggressively. It features 18-24" tall spikes of pink flowers in summer. Can tolerate wet conditions.

Narrowleaf Mountain Mint

Pycanthemum tenuifolium \$14.00

This native mint featuring densely branching fine foliage that attracts so many pollinators it practically buzzes all summer long. A very competitive workhorse for extreme sites and slopes, it will spread slowly so give it some room to grow. Deer and rabbit resistant.













Prairie Coneflower

Ratibida columnifera 'Red Midget' \$14.00

A seed selection of a prairie native, this plant does best in well drained soils and is drought resistant. Excellent for naturalizing, it will get 18–36" tall and wide. Deer resistant.

Wild Petunia

Ruellia humilis \$14.00

A drought-tolerant prairie native with lavender-blue flowers. Will grow 24–36" tall and does well in pots or a garden setting. Can seed vigorously so may spread around in the garden flower bed. Deer resistant.

Salvia

Salvia 'Bumbleberry' ^{PP31602} \$14.00

This vibrant pink and purple flowering salvia will make a statement in the garden. Compact at 12" tall. Pollinator friendly and deer resistant.

Salvia 'Moulin Rouge' \$14.00

A pink flowering form of the hardy garden salvia, this plant produces 24" tall spikes of rosy pink flowers. Pollinator friendly and deer resistant.

Salvia nemerosa 'May Night' \$14.00

A top landscape performer with dense spikes of violetpurple flowers. Blooms reach 18" tall in early summer. Pollinator friendly and deer resistant.













Pincushion Flower

Scabiosa colmbaria 'Butterfly Blue' \$14.00

This lavender blue flower sits atop wiry stems hovering over a rosette of leaves. Excellent cut flowers and popular with pollinators. Grows 12–18" tall and spreads about 15" wide. Does well in alkaline soil.

Little Bluestem

Schizachyrium scoparium 'Smoke Signals' \$14.00

An ornamental grass that features blue-green foliage through much of the summer then turns more purple in the fall. Will grow 3–4' tall in hot, dry areas.

Stonecrop

Sedum 'Carl['] \$14.00

This variety of the common Autumn Joy sedum feature magenta flowers on a compact plant growing about 18" tall. Gray green leaves. Tolerates poor soils.

Stonecrop

Sedum 'Cherry Tart' ^{PP24603} \$14.00

Stunning cherry-red leaves of this creeping succulent look fantastic in a rock garden, flower bed or as a general groundcover. Brilliant pink flowers bloom in late summer. Prefers well-drained soils and intolerant of wet soils.

Stonecrop

Sedum 'Night Light' ^{PPAF} \$14.00

This upright stonecrop features dark green leaves on purple stems that provide an excellent backdrop for the light yellow blooms in the fall. Grows 22–26" tall.













Goldenrod

Solidago rugosa 'Fireworks' \$14.00

A native clump forming plant with radiating flower form covered in yellow blooms in late summer. It is a pollinator magnet attracting bees, butterflies and beetles. It performs well dry soils but can tolerate wetter situations if needed. Will gradually spread by creeping rhizomes.

Goldenrod

Solidago sphacelata 'Golden Fleece' \$14.00

This goldenrod has full sprays of golden yellow flowers in late summer. Semi-evergreen foliage makes a great groundcover with stems that grow to 24". Popular with pollinators.

Ironweed

Vernonia lettermannii 'Iron Butterfly' \$14.00

This rugged perennial grows about 36" tall and is covered in purple blooms in late summer. Perfect for butterflies and bees yet the deer don't like it.

Speedwell

Veronica 'Very Van Gogh' \$14.00

Popular with honeybees, butterflies, and hummingbirds, this plant features spikes of purple flowers. Growing about 20" tall and wide it is a long blooming mid-late summer flower.

Perennials for Sunny and/or Shady Spots

These perennials like full sun but also will grow well with only 4 hours of direct sun. Some grow well in more shade. All plants in this section are in 1-gallon pots unless noted otherwise.

Bugleweed

Ajuga reptans 'Black Scallops' \$14.00

A spreading groundcover with dark colored leaves. In late spring, spikes of blue flowers bloom but the foliage is the real feature through the summer and fall. It does well in full sun, but it does equally well in the shade of a tree.

Allium

Allium 'Bubble Bath' \$14.00

This deer-resistant plant features clusters of 3" round light-purple flowers each spring. An ornamental onion, the flowers are smaller than the large bulb-like alliums and the slightly twisted leaves stay attractive through the fall.

Arkansas Blue Star

Amsonia hubrichtii \$14.00

This southern native is attractive in 3 seasons. Blue starshaped flowers bloom in spring and the soft, finely textured leaves just beg to be touched. In fall, the leaves turn a brilliant golden color for an added touch to the autumn garden. Deer resistant

Wild Columbine

Aquilegia canadensis \$14.00

This native plant features red nodding flowers in late April and early May. A short-lived perennial, it will selfseed easily. Naturalizes in wooded/shady conditions. Deer resistant











Columbine

Aquilegia caerulea 'Kirigami' \$14.00

These large flowering hybrids of an old-fashioned plant provide bright colors in the late spring garden. They do well in a little bit of shade and enjoy the spring sun. They do well as cut flowers.

Japanese Spikenard

Aralia c. 'Sun King' \$14.00

The large golden compound leaves measure 3 feet long. This part shade plant wants at least a few hours of sun a day to retain the chartreuse color in its leaves. This deer resistant plant features racines of small white flowers in late summer.

Astilbe

Astilbe 'Peach Blossom' \$14.00

This peach astilbe features 8" long lacy panicles of beefriendly flowers and blooms in early summer. It will get about 24" tall. Can thrive in full sun or full shade so very adaptable to many growing conditions. Deer resistant.

Turtlehead

Chelone lyonii 'Hot Lips' \$14.00

Pink turtlehead-shaped blooms cluster atop dark foliage on this stunning plant. This native blooms mid-to-late summer and is deer resistant. It grows 2-3' tall and prefers moist soils, performing exceptionally well on moist stream banks or in marshy areas.

Bush Clematis

Clematis 'Rain Dance' PP33875 \$14.00

This is a non-vining clematis that will grow to 42" so can benefit from staking or a garden obelisk. Indigo blue flowers make a stunning display.

Foxglove

Digitalis purpurea 'Candy Mountain' \$14.00

A classic in any garden. Pink bell-shaped flowers with speckled throats. This 3' tall plant is the natural source for the medicine digitalin. Will take plenty of sun as well.

Globe Thistle

Echinops 'Blue Glow' \$14.00

This well-behaved clumping perennial is topped with intense blue spheres during the summer. It is popular with many pollinators. Grows 30" tall. Makes a good cut flower for arrangements.

Bigroot Geranium

Geranium 'Ingwersen's Variety' \$14.00

This 12" tall plant will spread 15" wide to make an excellent groundcover. Light pink flowers. Easily grows in average soils. Blooms late spring into summer.

Hardy Geranium

Geranium maculatum 'Rozanne' \$14.00

This hardy geranium hybrid does well in heat and humidity. Blue flowers hover about the sprawling plant, which makes a good ground cover. Does well in full sun and prefers some afternoon shade.

Avens

Geum quellyon 'Blazing Sunset' \$14.00

A solid plant for the flower bed. Double scarlet-red flowers grow to 24" tall and will attract pollinators. A good cut flower that is also deer resistant.













Japanese Forest Grass

Hakonechloa m. 'Aureola' \$14.00

A grass for the shade garden with variegated but nearly all yellow leaves. A cascading habit makes it excellent along a garden path. A slow grower but will spread gradually.

Great Blue Lobelia

Lobelia siphilitica \$14.00

A wetland native with spikes of blue flowers that attract pollinators in late summer. Naturalizes well in moist sites but can tolerate drought and performs well in a garden flower bed. Plants will self-sow in the right conditions. Deer resistant.

Coral Honeysuckle

Lonicera sempervirens 'Major Wheeler' \$14.00

This is profuse orange cultivar of the native honeysuckle. A twining vine, it will grow nicely on a fence or trellis and the red flowers attract hummingbirds. Blooms more profusely in full sun but tolerates shade. Grows to about 10' tall.

Bee Balm

Monarda didyma 'Jacob Cline' \$14.00

This native cultivar was selected for its superior resistance to mildew. Large red flowers are a magnet for pollinators and hummingbirds. Blooms from June to August and will get 3–4 feet tall when in flower. Likes full sun and moist conditions but is adaptable and will spread readily.

Bee Balm

Monarda 'Electric Neon Purple' \$14.00

Another mildew resistant cultivar with bright fuchsia purple flowers. Will grow about 24" tall so a little more reserved for the garden.

Spotted Bee Balm

Monarda punctata \$14.00

This native features unusual flowers and it is a great addition to any native meadow or naturalistic planting. It grows 2-3' tall and performs well in dry to average soils. This is a pollinator magnet and deer resistant.

Itoh Peony

Paeonia 'Bartzella' \$40.00

This is an intersectional peony – a cross between a herbaceous peony and a tree peony, drawing on the best qualities of both species. Large flowers, long-lasting

healthy foliage, strong stems that won't bend in the rain and excellent winter hardiness. 'Bartzella' features numerous bright yellow flowers and can grow to 3' tall and wide, with a light sweet fragrance.

Peony

Paeonia 'Karl Rosenfield' \$20.00

This peony features fragrant double fuschia-red flowers. Will grow to about 36" tall and does well with a bit of staking to support the heavy flowers.

Great Coneflower


Rudbeckia maxima \$14.00

A tall perennial (grows 6–7'), this bright, erect plant with yellow ray flowers makes a statement in the garden. Blooms in mid summer. It likes average to moist soils and can spread more quickly in rich soils. It is a butterfly magnet and makes an excellent cut flower.

Brown-eyed Susan

Rudbeckia triloba \$14.00

This 3'tall flower is excellent for mass planting or naturalizing in a native garden. Popular with pollinators it will bloom in the middle of summer.













Betony Stachys monieri 'Hummelo' \$14.00

Spikes of lavender-purple flowers grow tall on leafless stems. Basal rosettes of dark green leaves form slowly spreading clumps. Deer resistant.

Culver's Root

Veronicastrum virginicum \$14.00

This native plant features dramatic white spikes growing 4-6' tall. It may be a little slow to get established, but it is a tough long-lasting plant. Very popular with bees, moths and butterflies.

Perennials for shady spots

These perennials like shade. Need less than 6 hours of direct sun a day. All plants in this section are in 1-gallon pots unless noted otherwise.

Lady's Mantle

Alchemilla mollis \$14.00

This plant has fine star-shaped yellow flowers in early summer, but the real attraction of this plant is the foliage. Fuzzy gray-green leaves catch water after a rain or morning dew and make the whole plant sparkle. A slow spreader, it works as a nice ground cover or edging plant. Deer resistant.



Japanese Anemone

Anemone 'Honorine Jobert' \$14.00

The tall rose-pink flowers of these fall-blooming plants are a perfect addition to a cottage garden where a little shade is present. A nice stop for butterflies in the fall garden. It is deer resistant.



Lady Fern

Athyrium filix-femina var. *angustum* 'Lady in Red' \$14.00

A 20–30" tall fern with red stems. A vigorous grower that thrives in bright shade and moist soils. Does not tolerate heavy clay soils. Can handle some sun if adequate moisture is provided.

Siberian Bugloss

Brunnera macrophylla 'Jack Frost' \$14.00

We get lots of comments and questions about this plant growing in the Water Garden and Jasmine allee. This cultivar features frosted green leaves and beautiful blue flowers in the spring. Grows 10" high and spreads out about 20"





Siberian Bugloss

Brunnera macrophylla 'Variegata' \$14.00

This form has more white frosting on the large leaves and really lights up darker spaces in the garden.

Bulblet Blader Fern

Cysopteris bulbifera \$14.00

This shade-loving fern prefers shady spots in rocky limestone soils. It will grow up to 24" tall. It produces small bulblets on the underside of the fronds to create new plants.

Lenten Rose

Helleborus 'Honeymoon Series' \$14.00

Blooming in late winter/early spring, Lenten roses are a welcome sign that spring is on its way. Numerous blossoms of single flowers on each plant provide a variety of colors. Good for naturalizing in shady areas, it will grow 18" tall and gradually spread. Deer resistant.

Lenten Rose

Helleborus 'Rio Carnival' \$14.00

A singular selection that features light yellow flowers with burgundy speckling.

Coral Bells

Heuchera 'Caramel' \$14.00

This cultivar features apricot to amber foliage. Drought tolerant and an excellent plant for the shade. Will get about 18" tall when in bloom. Will spread slowly as a clump and can be divided every few years.















Coral Bells Heuchera 'Pink Panther

This 12" tall cultivar features dark berry pink foliage that makes a great accent in a shady corner. Will spread slowly as a clump and can be divided every few years.

Coral Bells

Heucherella 'Catching Fire' \$14.00

Bright lime green leaves with dark flame markings in the center really pop in the shade. Clumps remain low at 10". Will spread slowly as a clump and can be divided every few years.

Dwarf Crested Iris

Iris cristata \$14.00

A native shade-loving iris that blooms in early spring. This diminutive plant only reaches 6-8" tall with swordlike leaves and blue-violet blooms. Spreads to form small colonies on the woodland floor.

Creeping Jacobs Ladder

Polemonium reptans \$14.00

An easy growing groundcover that does well moist shade and streambanks. The foliage grows about 12" tall and light blue flowers hover above. May go dormant in periods of drought.

Christmas Fern

Polystichium acrostichoides \$14.00

A workhorse in the shade garden, this fern maintains a tidy habit through until December. Works well with bulbs in the spring. Grows 18" high and wide.














Bowman's Root

Porteranthu trifoliatus 'Pink Profusion' \$14.00

This is a pink version of an easy growing native shade plant. Can hold its own against tree roots. The delicate flowers make a cut flower and are a great filler plant in the garden. Grows 2–3' tall.

Lungwort

Pulmonaria 'Twinkle Toes' \$14.00

This plant is a conversation piece for the shady space. Speckled green leaves make a great foil for other shady plants such as hosta and ferns, while the blue spring flowers provide a pop of color early in the growing season.

Foamflower

Tiarella cordifolia \$14.00

This native woodland plant makes a great groundcover, spreading slowly by stolons. 10" tall white spiky flowers bloom in late spring. Likes plenty of organic matter and consistent moisture.

Shrubs for sunny spots

Shrubs that do well with more than 6 hours of direct sun a day. Most shrubs are in 3-gallon pots.

Abelia

Abelia x grandiflora 'Little Richard' \$30.00

A compact shrub with glossy green leaves. In the summer fragrant white flowers bloom that provide excellent nectar for bees. Will grow 4' tall and wide. Deer resistant.

Butterfly Bush

Buddleia 'Pink Cascade' \$14.00

A butterfly bush where the pink blooms cascade downward, providing an unique look in the garden. In the summer fragrant white flowers bloom that provide excellent nectar for bees. Will grow 4' tall and wide. Deer resistant.

Butterfly Bush

Buddleia 'Queen of Hearts' \$14.00

A more compact shrub growing about 3' tall with large magenta red panicles of flowers. Heavy flower production adds a splash of color in the summer.

Blue Mist Shrub

Caryopteris x clandonensis \$14.00

Blue fragrant flowers attract bees and butterflies in late summer. A low growing deciduous shrub (2-3' tall) that may die back to the ground in severe winters. Can be cut back to maintain shape.













Button Bush

Cephalanthus occidentalis 'Sugar Shack' \$35.00

A large shrub for moist areas, this plant can get 12' tall and 8' wide. In summer large round pin-cushion shaped flowers bloom. Great wildlife value.

Japanese Plum Yew

Cephalotaxus harringtonia 'Fastigiata' \$40.00

A slow growing needled evergreen, the 'Fastigiata' cultivar grows 8–10' tall but only 4' wide. The fine needles stay evergreen and this is more deer resistant than the traditional yew.

Summersweet

Clethra alnifolia 'Sugartina' \$30.00

Spikes of fragrant white flowers cover this plant in midsummer. Blooms best in full sun but naturally grows under larger trees. Does well in moist soils. This cultivar remains compact, growing only 2–3' tall and 3–4' wide.

Yellowtwig Dogwood


Cornus alba 'Bud's Yellow' \$35.00

This cultivar has yellow stems that stand out in the winter months. Excellent in groupings or as a single specimen. Adaptable to a variety of conditions. Can get 6-8' tall.

Slender Deutzia

Deutzia gracilis \$30.00

A dense rounded deciduous shrub. In the summer fragrant white flowers bloom that provide excellent nectar for bees. Will grow 4' tall and wide. Deer resistant.













Hairy Bush-honeysuckle

Diervilla rivularis 'Kodiak Black' \$30.00

An easy to grow shrub that gets up to 4' tall. Dark foliage provides a great backdrop yellow flowers in early summer. Can handle sun or shade. Deer resistant.

Forsythia

Forsythia x 'Minfor6' \$35.00

This is a compact hybrid of the classic early spring flowering shrub, growing only 3' tall. Yellow flowers are 1" and upright.

Box-Leaved Holly

Ilex crenata 'Skypencil' \$40.00

This holly features small boxwood-like leaves on a tall narrow shrub. It will grow only 2-3' wide, but will get as tall as 10'. This is a female cultivar and will require a male holly to produce berries.

Inkberry

Ilex glabra 'Shamrock' \$30.00

An evergreen native holly that remains small (4' tall and wide'). Dark green leaves with black berry-like fruit. Prefers moist soil. Does best in sun but can handle shade.

Virginia sweetspire

Itea virginica 'Little Henry' \$ 35.00

A dwarf cultivar of a native shrub found naturally growing in wet locations. However, has good drought tolerance. Can handle full sun or shade. Spreads gradually and has long fragrant white flowers in late spring/early summer. Great fall foliage. Will get to 2' tall and 3' wide.













Singleseed Juniper

Juniperus squamata 'Blue Star' \$30.00

This dwarf cultivar is slow growing and will get only 1-3' tall and 4' wide. The dense mound features blue-gray leaves. Evergreen and prefers well drained soils.

Goji Berry

Lycium barbarum \$30.00

A deciduous shrub that produces edible berries after purple flowers bloom in the summer. Prefers well-drained, slightly alkaline soils. Can get 8' tall with 12' spread.

Japanese Andromeda

Pieris japonica 'Purity' \$40.00

This compact form of Andromeda stays about 3–4' tall and produces prolific white flowers in the spring. Leaves emerge with bronze coloring in the spring before coming dark green later in the season.

Scarlet Firethorn

Pyracantha x 'Lowboy' \$30.00

A low spreading shrub with glossy green leaves and bright bright orange berries in the fall. Will grow 3' tall and 8' wide. Best planted where thorns will not be a problem.

Highbush Blueberry

Vaccinum corymbosum 'Patriot' \$35.00

This upright cultivar grows 4-6' tall. A spring bloom leads to berries in the summer. While self-fertile, fruit production is improved with multiple shrubs planted in a group or hedge.















Prague Viburnum

Viburnum x pragense \$30.00

An evergreen hybrid viburnum that grows 8–12' tall. In the spring fragrant white flowers are on display, while it produces red to black berries in the fall.

Weigela

Weigela florida 'Tango' \$30.00

A compact shrub with profuse red funnel-shaped flowers. Will grow 2–3' tall and wide. Deer resistant and attractive to hummingbirds.

Shrubs for shady spots

Shrubs that are happy with less than six hours of direct sunlight Most shrubs are in 3-gallon pots

Hydrangea

Hydrangea macrophylla 'Forever Pink' \$30.00

This classic garden hydrangea features large globe-like blue flowers in mid-summer. Can grow 6' tall and wide and deer resistant.

Oakleaf hydrangea

Hydrangea quercifolia \$ 35.00

This native cultivar produces large white cone-shaped flowers. The oak-shaped leaves turn a bright burgundy in the fall for added interest. It will get 5' wide and tall. One is growing in the shade of the Pink Pavilion.

Rhododendron

Rhododendron catawbiense 'Chionoides' \$ 35.00

An evergreen shrub that grows 4' tall and up to 6' wide. White flowers with a yellow dorsal blotch bloom above large, glossy, dark green leaves. This is a native to the mountains of southern Virginia.

Rhodendron

Rhododendron x 'Lee's Dark Purple' \$30.00

A hybrid developed in the 1850s (*R. catawbiense* is one parent) with glossy green leaves. In the summer purple flowers bloom that provide excellent nectar for bees. Will grow 6–8' tall and wide. Deer resistant.











Doublefile Viburnum

Viburnum plicatum var. tomentosum 'Shasta' \$ 30.00

A broad spreading shrub that will get 6–7' tall but as wide as 10'. Large white lace-cap flowers top horizontal branches in the spring. Great fall color. Excellent for hedges or specimen plants. Does well in part shade but also in full sun.

Trees

Allegheny Serviceberry

Amelanchier laevis \$80.00

A small understory tree getting only 15–25' tall. Showy white flowers with round edible fruit that are good for pies, jellies, and jams—if you can beat the birds to them. 3 trees available in 7-gallon container.

Fringetree

Chionanthus virginicus \$30.00

A native small tree that grows 12–20' tall and wide. Also known as grancy graybeard. Very adaptable to soil types and grows best in full sun. White flowers in spring look like shredded petals and nice yellow leaves in the fall. 5 plants are available in 3-gallon containers.





Dogwood

Cornus x Rutdan 'Celestial' \$80.00

This is a vigorous disease resistant hybrid dogwood. The classic white dogwood with good fall color, it is perfect for the home garden. Can grow 18' tall and 15' wide. 3 plants are available in 7-gallon containers.

Japanese Cedar

Cryptomeria japonica 'Black Dragon' \$40.00

A compact cultivar which grows 7–10' tall and 5–7' wide with dark green foliage. Works well in formal plantings as a specimen plant. 6' plants are available in 3-gallon containers.







Nellie Stevens Holly

Ilex x 'Nellie R. Stevens' \$75.00

This is an evergreen holly hybrid that produces abundant berries. Glossy spiny leaves provide a great backdrop to seasonal berries. Grows 15–25' tall and 8–12' in a classic conical shape. 4 plants are available in 7-gallon containers.

Sweet Bay

Magnolia virginiana \$ 80.00

A small to medium tree that will grow 20–35' tall and wide. Native to Virginia's coastal plain and piedmont. Extremely fragrant white flowers in early summer. Great specimen tree for the garden or can tolerate wet soils. Semi-evergreen in the Winchester area. 1 plant is available in 7-gallon container.

Okame Cherry

Prunus x 'Okame' \$125.00

A small deciduous tree with an upright rounded crown. One of the earlier cherries to bloom, it announces the arrival of spring with a flair. 15–25' tall and 15–20' wide. 3 plants are available in 15-gallon containers.

Annuals, Herbs, Vegetables

The MSV will have a limited selection of summer annuals, herbs and vegetables available at the sale. Exact plants to be determined based on availability from the greenhouse as the gardens are planted for the summer.
