ABOUT THIS YEAR'S PICTURE: RACE INTO 2024!

Color or paint this picture that celebrates New Year's Eve and the special MSV exhibition *Marvelocity: The Art of Alex Ross.* The drawing was inspired by characters from the Marvel Universe on view in *Marvelocity,* the New Year's Eve apple drop in Old Town Winchester, and a 2.4-mile family fun run scheduled for New Year's Day on The Trails at the MSV.

At the MSV through February 18, 2024, *Marvelocity* presents the original art of world-famous comic book artist Alex Ross (b. 1970). For nearly 30 years, Ross has revitalized classic superheroes into fine art by illustrating characters including Spider-Man, Captain America, Thor, the Black Panther, and many others. The MSV exhibition includes more than 40 original paintings, lifelike three-dimensional head busts, and several of Ross's childhood drawings.
