Early Spring Flowering Bulbs

These bulbs will bloom in March for the Winchester area

Snow Crocus Mix

Crocus sp. 100 bulbs for \$ 30.00

Small white, yellow, and purple flowers announce that spring is on the way in a most cheerful manner. This mix of early blooming crocus is great for naturalizing in a lawn or a sunny woodland area. Likes well drained soil.



Netted Iris

Iris reticulata 'Harmony' 100 bulbs \$ 35.00

This very-early blooming, diminutive blue iris is the perfect harbinger for spring. Great for planting in mass or small clusters dotted throughout the garden. Deer resistant.





Mid-Spring Flowering Bulbs

These bulbs will bloom sometime between late March through April

Trout Lily - Pagoda

Erythronium 'Pagoda' 20 bulbs for \$ 37.00

This trout lily hybrid produces yellow flowers that stand out in a woodland setting. Blooming at only 10" tall, they make a nice foil with Virginia bluebells and other spring flowers. Let them naturalize and you will enjoy them for years to come.



Guinea Hen Flower

Fritillaria meleagris
100 bulbs for \$ 39.00

Also called the checkered lily, these delicate bell-shaped flowers perch atop 15" tall stems checkered in dark colors of reddish-brown and purple. Deer do not browse on these midspring bloomers. Left alone, they will gradually naturalize in the shady garden.



Yellow Crown Imperial

Fritillaria imperialis 'Maxima Lutea' 5 bulbs for \$ 48.00

A cluster of yellow flowers peek out under a tuft of leaves. The flowers stand tall on a 3-4' high stem and make a statement at the back of the spring border. The slightly malodorous plant discourages deer and other rodents.





Snowflake

Leucojum aestivum 50 bulbs for \$ 42.00

White bell-shaped flowers dangle from 25" tall arching stems in mid-April. They can tolerate moist soils if they have plenty of sun. This versatile bulb does well in a border garden, rock garden or along a stream. Deer and rodent resistant.



Canaliculatus daffodil

Narcissus canaliculatus 50 bulbs for \$ 38.00

A fragrant miniature daffodil. Each bulb produces four to seven small-cupped flowers on 8-10" tall stalks. Great for planting along a walk where the perfume will greet each passerby.



Daffodil - Carlton

Narcissus 'Carlton' 25 bulbs for \$ 33.00

This is an early blooming two-tone, yellow-flowered daffodil. The large blooms perch atop 14" tall stems. It multiplies easily so it is an investment for many springs to come. Deer and rodent resistant





Peony Tulip - Angelique

Tulipa 'Angelique' 25 bulbs for \$ 29.00

This pink, double-flowering form of the tulip is a real charming addition to any garden. One of the later tulips to bloom in the season, it grows to about 16" tall. A can't miss for our Apple Blossom Festival season.



Tulip - Maureen

Tulipa 'Maureen' 25 bulbs for \$ 33.00

This single late tulip is a tall (25"), ivory white tulip featuring a goblet shaped flower. It is a classic for any garden. It is one of the last tulips to bloom, generally late April in Winchester and is stunning with other spring flowers.



Species Tulip – Peppermint Stick

Tulipa clusiana 'Peppermint Stick' 50 bulbs for \$ 38.00

This graceful species tulip is pink on the outside but opens to show off a white interior with a purple heart. This bulb perennializes better than many other tulips, providing years of pleasure.





Late-Spring Flowering Bulbs

These bulbs will bloom sometime between early May and early June

Allium - Purple Sensation

Allium 'Purple Sensation' 25 bulbs for \$ 25.00

This perennial features a 4" globe of purple flowers blooming on stalks over 2 feet tall. This late blooming bulb makes a great cut or dried flower. Looks good in clusters or as a mass planting. Deer resistant.



Camass

Camassia leichtlinii 'Caerulea' 10 bulbs for \$ 25.00

Clusters of blue star-shaped flowers rise 36" above a clump of foliage in late April and early May. This North American native does well in moist conditions, and we have planted many of them in Kathie's Spring Garden. Great for naturalizing and deer resistant.



Spanish Bluebells

Hyacinthoides hispanica 'Excelsior' 25 bulbs for \$ 21.00

These late blooming spikes of lavender-blue flowers are great for naturalizing under shade trees. Blooming in later spring, we have a nice showing of them under the sycamore in Kathie's spring garden. Naturalizes well and will spread. Foliage will go dormant in the summer so it does well with late flowering summer perennials.
