### About this year's picture:

For inspiration visit the Patsy Cline Historic House and enjoy *Becoming Patsy Cline* at the MSV. Shenandoah Valley artist John Burns drew this year's picture.

Located at 608 South Kent Street in Old Town Winchester, the **Patsy Cline Historic House** showcases the time 1948 to 1953 when Patsy and her family lived there. The house is open April through October from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Tuesday through Saturday and from 1 to 4 p.m. on Sunday. In November and December, the house is open on Friday and Saturday from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m., and on Sunday from 1 to 4 p.m. Admission is \$8 or \$6 for seniors and youth ages 11 to 18. ### Celebrate First Night at the MSV!

First Night Winchester 2014 buttons will be available for purchase in the MSV Museum Store from December 6 through 31 (admission not required to visit store). Everyone wearing a First Night Winchester 2014 button will receive FREE admission to the MSV on Tuesday, December 31, 2013. On New Year's Eve, the MSV will be open from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. Children's musician Peter McCorry will perform at 1 and 3 p.m., free face painting and balloon creations will be offered from 11 a.m. until 3 p.m., and Ronald McDonald will appear from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m. Admission on December 31 is free to MSV Members, children 12 & under, and those wearing First Night Winchester buttons. All others: \$10; \$8 senior/student (includes the show and gallery admission).
