## **Early Spring Flowering Bulbs**

These bulbs will bloom in mid-late March in Winchester.

### **Netted Iris**

*Iris reticulata* 'Harmony'  
100 bulbs \$ 30.00

This very-early blooming, diminutive blue iris is the perfect harbinger for spring. Great for planting in mass or small clusters dotted throughout the garden. Deer resistant.



### **Grape Hyacinth**

*Muscari armeniacum*  
100 bulbs for \$ 25.00

Small dense spikes of blue flowers make a great companion for many other spring blooming bulbs and flowers. Planted as a group they create a fabulous blue carpet for any mid-spring display.

## Miniature Daffodil - Rapture

*Narcissus 'Rapture'*

100 bulbs for \$ 70.00

This early blooming miniature daffodil is small but makes a big splash when displayed in a mass. It only grows 12-14" tall. Known as a cyclamineus daffodil, it features a long cup and pulled back petals. Also good scattered in a rock garden. Deer resistant.



## Mid-Spring Flowering Bulbs

These bulbs will bloom sometime between late March through April

## Daffodil – 40 for Spring

*Narcissus*

100 bulbs for \$ 95.00

This blend of 40 different varieties of daffodils will provide you a broad spectrum of larger landscape daffodils from white, to yellow and every combination in between. Selected for a mass planting, the different bulbs will bloom over a long period of time through the spring. Great for naturalizing. Deer resistant.



## Trout Lily - Pagoda

*Erythronium 'Pagoda'*

25 bulbs for \$ 35.00

This trout lily hybrid produces yellow flowers that stand out in a woodland setting. Blooming at only 10" tall, they make a nice foil with Virginia bluebells and other spring flowers. Let them naturalize and you will enjoy them for years to come.

## Guinea Hen Flower

*Fritillaria meleagris*  
25 bulbs for \$ 10.00

Also called the checkered lily, these delicate bell-shaped flowers perch atop 15” tall stems checkered in dark colors of reddish-brown and purple. Deer do not browse on these mid-spring bloomers. Left alone, they will gradually naturalize in the shady garden.



## Red Crown Imperial

*Fritillaria imperialis* ‘Rubra Maxima’  
5 bulbs for \$ 35.00

A cluster of orange-red flowers peek out under a tuft of leaves. The flowers stand tall on a 3-4’ high stem and make a statement at the back of the spring border. The slightly malodorous plant discourages deer and other rodents.



## Tulip Mix – French Blend Rose

*Tulipa* sp.  
100 bulbs for \$ 70.00

It’s hard to beat the beauty of a mass planting of tulips in full bloom. This selection of large single late tulips in shades of pink, rose, and apricot are perfect for a late April display in Winchester.

## Peony Tulip - Angelique

*Tulipa* 'Angelique'

25 bulbs for \$ 25.00

This pink, double-flowering form of the tulip is a real charming addition to any garden. One of the later tulips to bloom in the season, it grows to about 16" tall. A can't miss for our Apple Blossom Festival season.



## Late-Spring Flowering Bulbs

These bulbs will bloom sometime between early May and early June

### Allium - Globemaster

*Allium* 'Globemaster'

5 bulbs for \$ 35.00

A large 8" globe of purple flowers blooms on three feet tall stalks. This late blooming bulb makes a great cut or dried flower. We have planted them in the Perennial Garden and the Knot Garden, where they happily peek over the boxwood hedges. Deer resistant.



### Tumbleweed Onion

*Allium schubertii*

5 bulbs for \$ 15.00

This heirloom allium features a large star shaped flower (10-12" across) that is a definite conversation piece in the late spring garden. Wants full sun and grows to 20" tall. Perfect for drying. Deer resistant
