Opportunities

Once you have completed training, volunteer opportunities include:

Administrative Volunteer

Work in various MSV administrative departments. Duties may include scanning, organizing, filing, mailings and other projects as needed under the direction of the department manager.

Collections Department Volunteer

Projects assigned as needed by Collections Department staff such as data entry and library support.

Education Department Volunteer

Assist with youth and adult programs such as ticket taking, organizing material for craft programs and assisting with summertime youth outdoor events.

Gallery Support Volunteer

Greet visitors, offer gallery orientation, answer questions, and direct guests to exhibits.

Gardens and Grounds Volunteer

Work with Gardens and Grounds staff in planting, weeding, pruning, mulching, and other tasks as needed.

Special Events Volunteer

Assist at indoor and outdoor events taking tickets, distributing guest wrist bands, and registering guests. This is a great opportunity to enjoy events or concerts while helping out!

Guest Services Volunteer

Greet visitors, hand out maps, and provide orientation on the MSV campus at the Visitor Services desk. Great for those who enjoy working and engaging with the public.

Volunteers have the opportunity to attend periodic training throughout the year for new exhibitions, garden updates, safety and security, and other volunteer education enrichment sessions. All volunteers work with the public and a background check is required.
